

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



Students can qualify for admission to the Bachelor Degree programmes offered at the University College in one of several ways:

For Entry as Freshman

CXC or Cambridge examinations, including English, taken at one sitting. *CXC grades must be Grade I - III at General or Technical Level (or grade I - II if taken before 1998); Grades must be A, B or C.*

Four passes

-OR-

As above, CXC or Cambridge examinations, including English, taken at more than one sitting

Five passes

-OR-

Combined SAT score

1425

(min. 400)

-OR-

Successful completion of a Certificate programme at the University College, with a 'B' or above in both Mathematics and English.

3.00 GPA

Mature Students (21 years or older) should complete the Associate Degree Programme before applying for the Bachelors.

Please note that in no case may CXC passes at the Basic Level be used to satisfy the entry requirements for the Associate Degree programme.

For entry as Junior:

Completion of an approved Associate Degree. Candidates who have not done the prerequisite courses will be required to complete these before enrolling for subsequent courses.

PROGRAMME CONTENT

Bachelor Degree students are required to complete a total of 42 courses, a total of 130 credit hours to earn the Bachelor Degree.

In 2004, the name of the institution was changed from Community College of the Cayman Islands to the University College of the Cayman Islands and 4 year degree programmes were introduced.

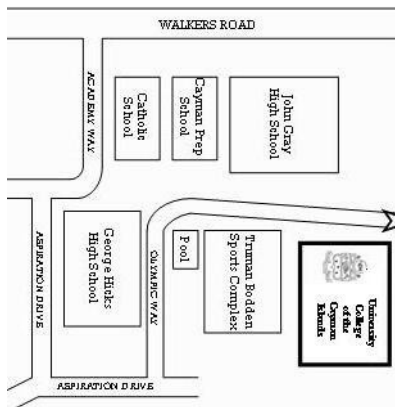
The University College currently offers a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration in five concentrations: Accounting, Economics, Finance, Management and Marketing.
